2024-2025 Novavax, Adjuvanted COVID-19 vaccine Ordering Guidance

Reason / Information:

The US Army Medical Materiel Agency Distribution Operations Center (USAMMA DOC) in conjunction with Defense Health Agency Medical Logistics (DHA MEDLOG) are providing ordering guidance for the 2024-2025 Novavax, Adjuvanted COVID-19 vaccine. REASON: On 30 August 2024, the U.S. Food and Drug Administration granted emergency use authorization (EUA) for an updated version of the Novavax COVID-19 vaccine that more closely targets currently circulating variants to provide better protection against serious consequences of COVID-19, including hospitalization and death.

Disposition / Instructions:

ACTIONS NEEDED:

1) Medical Treatment Facilities (MTFs) and vaccination sites can begin submitting orders through Prime Vendor Pharmacy (PVP) program with AmerisourceBergen (AB) for the 2024-2025 Novavax, Adjuvanted COVID-19 vaccine using their normal Defense Logistics Medical Standard Support (DMLSS)/Theater Enterprise-Wide Logistics System (TEWLS) ordering process for prime vendor (PV) ordering by setting the source of supply (SOS) to PVP for any of the national drug codes (NDC) listed below. Below are some ordering reminders:

----- COVID-19 Vaccines are no a longer a free issue item. Coordinate with your financial team to ensure funding is available for the purchasing of the vaccine.

----- MTFs submitting COVID orders within FY25 should tag all 2024-2025 COVID-19 vaccine purchases with FCA Code 4873.

----- COVID-19 vaccines will not be tracked within the DMLSS Assemblage Management

module.

- 2) CONUS PVP Customers, when ordering/receiving COVID-19 vaccines must remember the following:
- ---- Novavax is a standard refrigerated product which will move through the existing regional Distribution Centers (DCs), following the current CONUS Cold Chain Management (CCM) order and delivery process.
- ----- Standard systematic order confirmation and scheduled delivery will occur at at an appropriate time.
- ----- Product will be packaged in existing AB reusable tote containers, utilizing the standard tote reclamation process.
- ---- Delivery will be made with existing regional contract couriers.
- ---- Minimum ordering quantity: 1 carton of 10 doses per order.
- 3) OCONUS PVP Customers when ordering/receiving COVID-19 vaccines must remember the following:
- ----- Novavax product will ship in DLAs (PVPs) standard refrigerated (2-8C) shipping package, to include an orange-labeled Sensitech TempTale (at full shelf life)
- ----- Customers will follow the same standard receiving process as all other PVP CCM shipments.
- ----- DLA Troop Support CCM may continue to send pre-alerts emails or customers will receive the PVs standard automated shipping alerts (which are in the process of being updated/streamlined).
- ---- Minimum ordering quantity: 1 carton of 10 doses per order.

NOTE: OCONUS sites are encouraged to order Spikevax and Novavax vaccine for their adult population as one of two alternatives while the shipping lanes are being established for the Pfizer Comirnaty, Never Frozen (NF), Vaccine.

- 4) Navy Fleet assets will order by placing MILSTRIP orders directly with DLA to utilize the Direct Vendor Delivery (DVD) program, as currently done for all other non-DLA depot stocked vaccines. The Fleet Prime Vendor program cannot support COVID vaccine requirements.
- 5) Non-PVP customers should order through their Theater Lead Agent for Medical Materiel (TLAMM), which is the standard SOS for most vaccines, or utilize MILSTRIP orders directly with DLA to utilize the DVD program.
- 6) MTFs with questions or concerns related to the DLA Cold Chain program and/or product quality should continue to contact the DLA Troop Support Cold Chain program office, per the terms of the PVP contract. Any questions or concerns related to the PVP program and/or product availability/information should continue to contact their AB DoD Customer Care Representative.
- 7) Listed below you will find the prime vendor ordering number (PVON) for both CONUS and OCONUS. Please ensure the correct PVON is used upon ordering. Incorrect codes may result in orders being canceled.
