**Were you deployed in the Southwest Asia theater of operations, Egypt, or Somalia, from August 2, 1990, to August 31, 2021, or in Afghanistan, Djibouti, Jordan, Lebanon, Syria, Uzbekistan, or Yemen, from September 11, 2001, to August 31, 2021? If so, you are eligible for and may have been automatically enrolled in the Airborne Hazards and Open Burn Pit Registry.**

### **What are the benefits of enrollment in the registry?**

- Helps the Department of Veterans' Affairs (VA) to better understand the potential health effects of exposure to airborne hazards during military service.
- Enables enhanced care and benefits options for your fellow soldiers, airmen, sailors and Marines.
