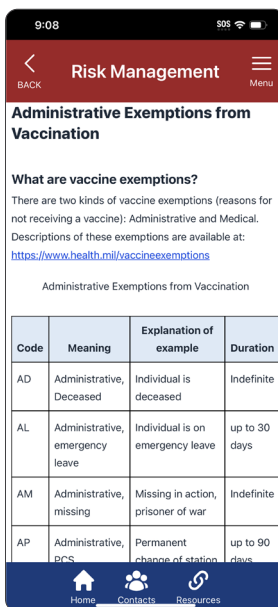
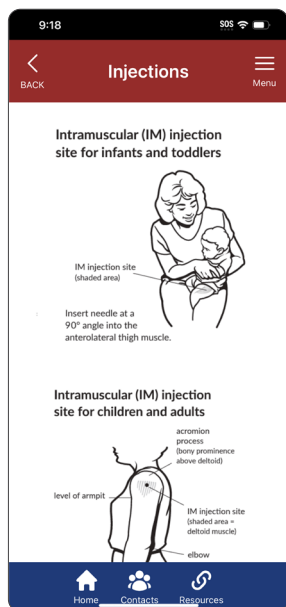
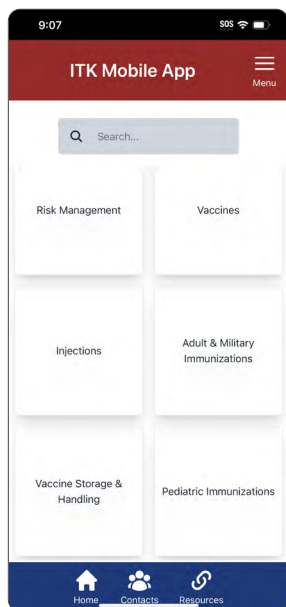


The Immunization Toolkit is a practical reference guide which facilitates and enhances the delivery of immunization services to Department of Defense beneficiaries. The Defense Health Agency Immunization Healthcare Division (DHA-IHD) develops the ITK following evidence-based, peer-reviewed published medical research, national recommendations, and clinical practice guidelines.

The ITK augments DOD policy, guidance from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, and the Food and Drug Administration.

DHA-IHD staff are immunization experts who provide timely professional advice to health care workers, uniformed service members, and beneficiaries on vaccine effectiveness and safety. They also address concerns regarding adverse vaccine reactions and work with the Vaccine Adverse Events Reporting System registry to provide long-term clinical case management and medical exemption tracking of beneficiaries.

This toolkit is managed by the Solution Delivery Division Web & Mobile Technology Program Management Office.
