

Defense Medical Human Resources System (DMHRSi) FACT SHEET

DMHRSi is a human resource management tool that delivers time-sensitive data that supports Army, Navy, Air Force, and Defense Health Agency functional requirements, and other human resource activities within the Military Health System.

DMHRSi integrates human resource data from multiple sources, offering ready access to manpower, labor cost assignment, education and training, and readiness information across the MHS. The system facilitates efficient contingency planning for medical personnel readiness, training, and finances; ultimately enhancing world-wide visibility of our most valued asset – people. More than 158 military hospitals and clinics and 170,000 users worldwide use DMHRSi.
