
Dear Mr. Chairman:

The Department's response to House Report 118-125, page 207, accompanying H.R. 2670, the National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2024, "Potential Benefits of Increasing Availability of Chiropractic Care for Servicemembers," is enclosed.

The report provides an overview of the current availability of chiropractic preventative care through TRICARE services, the proportion of active duty Service members (ADSMs) receiving care for musculoskeletal injuries that could benefit from chiropractic care if it were available on the member's respective installation, and the potential benefit on-site chiropractic care for preventative treatment would bring to ADSMs and medical options available to them. Chiropractic care, delivered through the Chiropractic Health Care Program for ADSMs, has been shown to lead to moderate short-term improvements in low back pain intensity, disability, and health-related quality of life measures. Review of current data indicates that an additional 12,372 ADSMs per year could receive chiropractic care if it were available on the member's respective installation.



Potential Benefits of Increasing Availability of Chiropractic Care for Service Members

February 2025

The estimated cost of this report or study for the Department of Defense (DoD) is approximately \$15,000.

This includes \$9,800 in expenses and \$5,300 in DoD labor.

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INTRODUCTION

This report is in response to House Report 118–125, page 207, accompanying H.R. 2670, the National Defense Authorization Act (NDAA) for Fiscal Year (FY) 2024, “Potential Benefits of Increasing Availability of Chiropractic Care for Service Members.” The report addresses the value of chiropractic preventive care in decreasing musculoskeletal injuries (MSKIs) and early separation among Service members, and it includes:

1. The current availability of chiropractic preventative care through TRICARE services;
2. The proportion of Service members receiving care for MSKIs that could benefit from chiropractic care if it were available on their respective installation; and
3. The potential benefit on-site chiropractic care for preventative treatment would bring to Service members and medical options available to them.

BACKGROUND

MSKIs are defined as musculoskeletal disorders resulting from mechanical energy transfer, including traumatic and overuse injuries, which may cause pain and/or limit function. They are a major concern for military readiness, accounting for over 2 million health care visits and 25 million lost duty days annually, with health care costs exceeding \$700 million per year.¹ In 2022, “other back problems” were the most common medical encounters among musculoskeletal diseases, affecting over 232,887 active duty Service members (ADSMs) with over 1 million encounters reported.² MSKIs can detract from ADSM readiness and deployability, which can have a significant impact on military operations. They are also responsible for exorbitant medical costs, including service-connected disability compensation. A significant subset of ADSMs also develop chronic pain or long-term disability after injury, which may increase their risk for chronic disease or secondary health deficits potentially associated with MSKIs.³ Chiropractic care may play a role in enhancing the operational readiness and quality of life of the fighting force by preventing MSKIs through the utilization of chiropractic diagnosis and treatment services, including prevention, health promotion, education, and research.

Doctors of chiropractic have been providing chiropractic care in the Military Health System (MHS) for almost 30 years as independent licensed practitioners. Presently, doctors of chiropractic (Federal civilian and contract) care for members of the Army, Navy, Air Force, Space Force, Marine Corps, Coast Guard, Public Health Service, and National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration.

Section 731 of the NDAA for FY 1995 (Public Law 103–337) required the Secretary of Defense to develop and carry out a demonstration program to evaluate the feasibility and advisability of furnishing chiropractic care through the medical care facilities of the Armed Forces.⁴ The initial Chiropractic Health Care Demonstration Project started at 10 military bases and was a 3-year study of the feasibility and advisability of integrating chiropractic care in the MHS. The Demonstration Project showed positive results treating low back pain, was extended

for 2 more years, and expanded to three additional military facilities.⁵ The Demonstration Project concluded in 1999. Section 702 of the Floyd D. Spence NDAA for FY 2001 (Public Law 106–398) required the Secretary of Defense to complete development of a plan to provide chiropractic health care services and benefits, as a permanent part of the Defense Health Program (including the TRICARE program), for all members of the Uniformed Services who are entitled to care under 10 U.S.C. § 1074(a) at designated sites. The plan had to provide for phased-in implementation over a 5-year period, beginning on October 1, 2001. These new clinics began to open in 2002.⁶ In 2007, the then-Assistant Secretary of Defense for Health Affairs (ASD(HA)) determined that the Department fully implemented the chiropractic health care benefits program, but in 2013, the then-ASD(HA) issued a memorandum that permitted chiropractic services to be added at military medical treatment facilities (MTFs) that did not previously offer the service, subject to approval procedures and available funding.⁷

The scope of privileges for doctors of chiropractic includes evaluation, diagnosis, and treatment of active duty patients, referred from other providers, with disorders of the musculoskeletal system. Chiropractic treatment includes the use of spinal manipulative therapy and/or other forms of manual therapy on articulations and/or muscular, tendonous, and ligamentous soft tissues of the body, with emphasis on the spinal column.⁸ Although the chiropractic scope of privileges includes all disorders of the musculoskeletal system, referrals for chiropractic care are almost exclusively for spine column diagnoses. During Calendar Year (CY) 2023, 95 percent of chiropractic evaluations were for spinal injury or headache diagnosis.⁹ Doctors of chiropractic struggle to meet the high demand for spine care, as demonstrated by the 40 day average wait time from referral to evaluation during CY 2023.¹⁰ From a practical standpoint, doctors of chiropractic within the MHS treat almost exclusively spine patients due to referring provider tendencies and a high demand for spine care. Beyond spine care, doctors of chiropractic may provide care that enhances operational readiness and quality of life for members of the uniformed services when compared to usual medical care alone. However, there is insufficient evidence to determine long term benefits of chiropractic care, impact on military readiness, and early separation rates due to MSKI.

1. CURRENT AVAILABILITY OF CHIROPRACTIC PREVENTATIVE CARE THROUGH TRICARE SERVICES

There are three types of chiropractic preventative care. Chiropractic primary prevention care deals with the prevention of disease in healthy people, secondary prevention is used to prevent a condition from recurring, and tertiary prevention is often defined as maintaining at a reasonable level a chronic condition that cannot be reversed. Within the local community and direct care system, very few patients are referred to chiropractic services for primary preventative care.¹¹ Therefore, this report will focus on chiropractic care consisting of evaluating, diagnosing, and treating existing MSKIs along with secondary and tertiary preventative care.

Chiropractic care, preventative or otherwise, is not covered as a TRICARE Basic (i.e., medical) benefit in the private sector. Chiropractic care outside an MTF is only available at the ADSM's personal expense.¹² Chiropractic care is currently available at 77 MTFs (Table 1). Note that the lowest volume clinics typically treated at least 300 unique ADSMs annually.

MTFs with fewer than 4,000 enrollees in the area have not found it cost effective to add chiropractic services. In CY 2023, 50,477 unique ADSMs received chiropractic care, totaling 231,317 encounters. For a full list of MTFs with chiropractic care or with chiropractic care within 50 driving miles, see the Appendix.

2. THE PROPORTION OF SERVICE MEMBERS RECEIVING CARE FOR MSKIs THAT COULD BENEFIT FROM CHIROPRACTIC CARE IF IT WERE AVAILABLE ON THEIR RESPECTIVE INSTALLATIONS

In July 2023, there were 1,532,306 ADSMs enrolled in the Defense Enrollment Eligibility Reporting System (DEERS). July 2023 is used because DoD-wide enrollment is relatively static, and enrollment is a monthly measure. Of those ADSMs enrolled in DEERS, 878,388 (57.3 percent) were enrolled to an MTF within 50 driving miles of MTF chiropractic care, whereas 326,063 (21.3 percent) were enrolled to MTFs where chiropractic care was not available within 50 driving miles (Table 2).

Of the 887,388 ADSMs who had access to chiropractic care at an MTF within 50 driving miles, 50,477 (5.7 percent) received chiropractic care in CY 2023. To calculate the potential number of ADSMs who could possibly benefit from chiropractic care, this report will assume similar chiropractic utilization patterns if added to other MTFs. Therefore, based on current chiropractic referral patterns and demand levels, roughly 5.7 percent of ADSMs at any installation would benefit from chiropractic care. However, it is not cost effective to resource specialty care such as chiropractic at MTFs with enrollment less than 4,000 ADSMs.

Of the 1,532,306 ADSMs enrolled in DEERS (July 2023), 322,484 (21 percent) were enrolled to MTFs where chiropractic care was not available within 50 driving miles of the enrollment sites with greater than 4,000 ADSMs enrolled (Table 3). Using the estimate of 5.7 percent, Table 3 includes the number of ADSMs who could benefit from the addition of chiropractic care if it were available on the installation. In total, an estimated 217,047 ADSMs would gain access to proximate MTF chiropractic care, and 12,372 ADSMs could receive a direct benefit from chiropractic treatment.

3. THE POTENTIAL BENEFIT ON-SITE CHIROPRACTIC CARE FOR PREVENTATIVE TREATMENT WOULD BRING TO SERVICE MEMBERS AND MEDICAL OPTIONS AVAILABLE TO THEM

Section 725 of the NDAA for FY 2010 (Public Law 111–84) required the Secretary of Defense to conduct chiropractic clinical trials to research the outcomes of chiropractic treatment in the MHS.¹² Clinical trials were completed consisting of 750 ADSMs with low back pain at three MTFs. In one trial, chiropractic care combined with usual medical care led to moderate improvement in low back pain intensity and disability at six weeks compared with usual care alone.¹³ In another trial, health-related quality of life, including physical function, sleep disturbance, anxiety, depression, and role satisfaction also improved for ADSMs with the addition of chiropractic care when compared to usual medical care alone.¹⁴ Although the outcomes of these clinical trials suggest moderate improvement in back pain, disability, and improvement in health-related quality of life with the addition of chiropractic care, additional research is needed as there was insufficient evidence to determine long-term benefit of chiropractic care and impact of chiropractic care on readiness.

With respect to care for the spinal column, which accounts for the overwhelming majority of chiropractic care for MSKIs, patients have multiple treatment options. Treatments for low back pain include self-care, non-drug and non-invasive therapies, drug therapies, invasive procedures, and surgery. The Department of Veterans Affairs (VA)/DoD Clinical Practice Guideline (CPG) for Diagnosis and Treatment of Low Back Pain, updated in 2022, includes details on most of these treatment options, and it provides an evidence-based framework for the diagnosis and treatment of patients with acute, subacute, or chronic low back pain with the aim of improving clinical outcomes. This CPG takes into account “patient preferences while aiming to treat the particular condition while optimizing the individual’s overall health and well-

being.”¹⁵ In addition to chiropractic care, these treatments can be delivered by physical therapy, physiatry, pain management, orthopedics, and primary care.

CONCLUSION

MSKIs, specifically back pain, have been leading causes of morbidity and disability among ADSMs throughout military history and have a significant effect on medical readiness. Doctors of chiropractic in the DoD treat almost exclusively spine patients, the majority of which have low back pain. Chiropractic care, delivered through the Chiropractic Health Care Program for ADSMs, has been shown to lead to moderate short term improvement in low back pain intensity, disability, and health-related quality of life measures. Chiropractic care is currently available at 77 MTFs. Additional research is needed to determine long-term effects of chiropractic care and its potential impact for decreasing MSKIs, preventing early separation, and improving medical readiness. The DoD remains committed to providing treatment for MSKIs as well as offering top-rated medical care to all ADSM and beneficiaries.
